1	1/3 Earth burnt up	On Earth → sores
2	1/3 Sea creatures & ships destroyed	Into Sea → blood
3	1/3 Rivers/Springs become bitter	Into Rivers/Springs → blood
4	1/3 Sun struck	On Sun → scorch people
5	Smoke from bottomless pit darkens sky; Locusts torment those of the Beast	Beast's kingdom plunged into darkness; Those of the Beast are in anguish
6	Mounted troops from across the Euphrates kill many	Euphrates dried up to prepare the way for the kings of the east
7	Voice from heaven	Voice from heaven

### Deborah/Barak vs Sisera


Then the people of Israel cried out to the LORD for help, for he had 900 chariots of iron and he oppressed the people of Israel cruelly for twenty years...


Behold, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, even those who pierced him, and all tribes of the earth will wail on account of him. Even so. Amen.
